TANK Expects 8,000 to Ride its Riverfest Shuttle on Sunday

(August 2007) – TANK is anticipating more than 8,000 riders this Sunday, Sept. 2, for its special Park & Ride Shuttle service to Riverfest. Last year, **8,310 people** took advantage of the convenient service and rode TANK's Riverfest Shuttle from three Park & Ride locations to Covington and Newport for the annual Labor Day fireworks celebration.

TANK's Riverfest Shuttle will leave from these Park & Ride locations on Sunday:

- Northern Kentucky University (NKU) Lot K (Ride to Newport)
- Buttermilk Park & Ride in Crescent Springs (Ride to Covington)
- Turfway Park Race Track in Florence (Ride to Covington)

The fare for the Riverfest Shuttle is \$5 for adults and \$3 for children (age 17 and under), roundtrip. Exact fare is required. Infants in arms may ride free, as long as they do not use a seat. Buses will begin leaving the Park & Rides at 4 p.m., with the last bus leaving each Park & Ride at 7:30 p.m. TANK's Riverfest Shuttles will operate approximately every 20-30 minutes. The Riverfest fireworks start about 9:05 p.m. The return service to the Park & Ride lots will begin in Covington and Newport immediately upon completion of the fireworks. The last Riverfest Shuttle bus will leave 30 minutes (no exceptions) after the conclusion of the fireworks.

Because of street closings, the Southbank Shuttle will be operating a modified riverfront route, beginning at 10 a.m. Sunday. The Southbank Shuttle will run until the fireworks begin. It will stop running when the fireworks begin and **will not** resume until the next day.
