**THE FOLLOWING SCHEDULES HAVE SLIGHT ROUTE AND TIME ADJUSTMENTS SO REMEMBER TO PICK UP A NEW SCHEDULE! NEW TIMES/SCHEDULES ARE EFFECTIVE 1/6/08.**

All TANK buses are now permanently using their new routing over the Clay Wade Bailey Bridge. Heavy vehicles, including TANK buses, have been banned from the Roebling Suspension Bridge.

### ROUTE CHANGES

**9 Taylor Mill Independence:**

- This route will no longer service Fidelity.

**Southbank Shuttle:**

- This route will now travel in and out of the Covington Transit Center. There have been route changes and stop changes throughout this route. Pick up a new map!

**8 Eastern Ave, Latonia Center:**

- Route will be extended to serve Fidelity, Wal-Mart, and the TANK Park & Ride/Hub.

# New TANK Ft. Wright Hub opens January 6, 2008

Starting January 6, 2008 the new eco-friendly Ft. Wright Transit Hub will open. The new hub will house 200 park and ride spaces and be serviced by five routes:

- # 5 Holman
- # 8 Eastern Ave, Latonia Center
- # 33 St. Elizabeth South—Thomas More College— Crestview Hills Town Center
- #28X Empire Drive Express
- #30X Independence Express

Passengers currently using the TANK park and ride will switch over to the new park and ride at this time. Entry and exit to the new facility will be via the new Fidelity road. A new access road directly to the park and ride is located behind Speedway and will allow a safer exit onto Madison Pike via a stoplight. We hope you enjoy the convenience, safety and amenities of our first hub!
